The Norwin Art League is a nonprofit organization that has provided art enrichment and art education to the Norwin communities since 1954. The League is one of the largest in Western Pennsylvania with a membership of over 140. Our members range from the experienced professional, to the talented amateur, to the "Sunday painter".

The Norwin Art League offers classes and workshops year 'round except for a break during the Christmas holiday and bad weather months of January and February. Classes and workshops are available for the beginner to the experienced. Each season offers new workshops in a variety of mediums from drawing and painting, to jewelry making and airbrush.

The Norwin Art League exhibits its members' artwork year 'round in seven different venues including Forbes Regional Hospital and local restaurants. Many of our members have sold their artwork through these venues.

The Norwin Art League holds two annual art exhibits that have become well known in the area for their excellence in showcasing our local artists. Members are encouraged to participate in the competition and to offer their work for sale if they wish to do so.

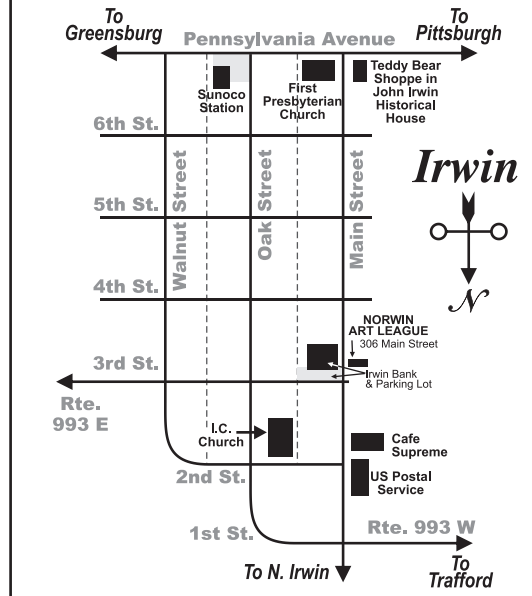
WHY BECOME A MEMBER?

Turn left at Immaculate Conception Church on 2nd Street. Go 1/2 block, park in public parking lot on right, not in restaurant lot.
